

**Lieutenant Colonel Thomas M. Fresenius**  
**Office of Counter Terrorism**  
**New York State Police**

Thomas M. Fresenius is a Lieutenant Colonel and a 28-year veteran of the New York State Police.

Lt. Colonel Fresenius entered the State Police Academy on September 24, 1979, and has held a myriad of positions in both the Uniform Force and the Bureau of Criminal Investigation. Responsibilities included the following: Sergeant assigned to the SP Boston in Troop A, supervising Uniform Patrol operations; Investigator assigned to the New York Drug Enforcement Task Force in New York City; Troop G back room assignments for the Bureau of Criminal Investigation; assigned as a Narcotics Lieutenant at Division Headquarters in Albany, New York; Captain/BCI assigned to the Inspection/Internal Affairs Bureau; Detail Commander of the Special Investigations Unit (SIU), which is a specialized unit responsible for major criminal investigations involving traditional and non-traditional organized crime activities, money laundering, and public corruption; Led the development and oversight of the statewide Auto Theft Unit and the Cigarette Smuggling Enforcement Unit; Major/SIU, maintaining oversight of the SIU as well as members assigned to the Upstate Regional Joint Terrorist Task Forces; Staff Inspector in Field Command, Office of the Assistant Deputy Superintendent/BCI, responsible for the oversight of the criminal investigative activities, narcotics enforcement programs, BCI policy development, as well as other BCI investigative and support programs statewide; Directed the development of the new Gun Investigation Unit and the Computer Crimes Unit expansion initiative.

On August 9, 2007, Lt. Colonel Fresenius was appointed to his current position in Field Command, Assistant Deputy Superintendent of the Office of Counter Terrorism. This position oversees the New York State Intelligence Center, and the Investigative and Response & Training platforms for the State Police Counter Terrorism program.

Lieutenant Colonel Fresenius is a member of the New York State Governor's Homeland Security Executive Council, New York State Executive Committee on Counter Terrorism, International Association of Chiefs of Police Organized Crime Committee, International Association of Chiefs of Police Committee on Terrorism, and the New York State Joint Terrorism Task Force Executive Council.
